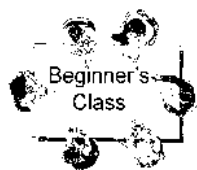

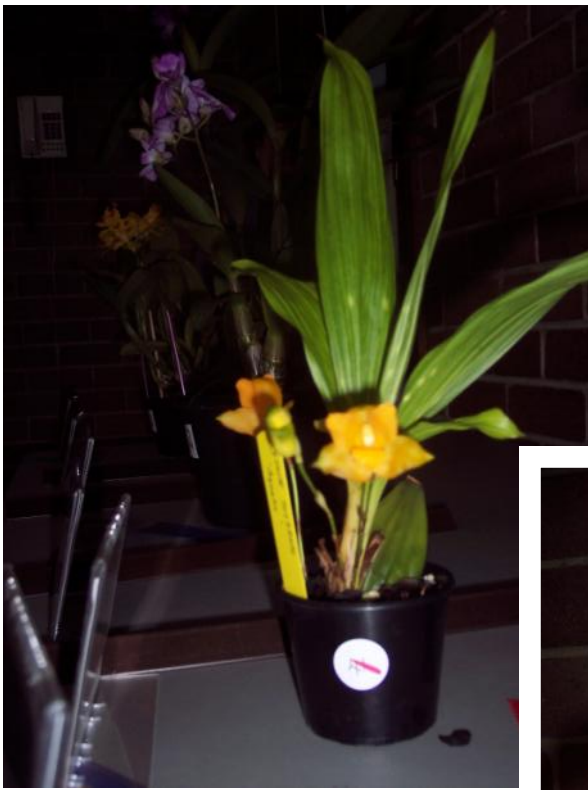

Some errors have been marked with an asterisk (*) or Question Mark (?) Please ask Show Marshalls for assistance in correcting your labels.

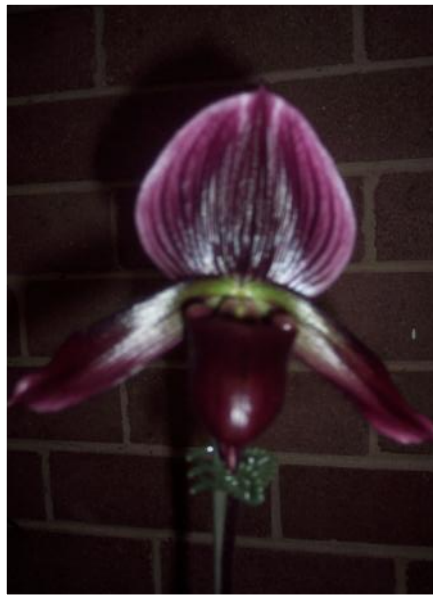
- The correct abbreviation for *Cattleya* is C.

To Ha Luong 's *Lycaste cochleata*

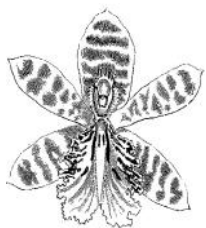
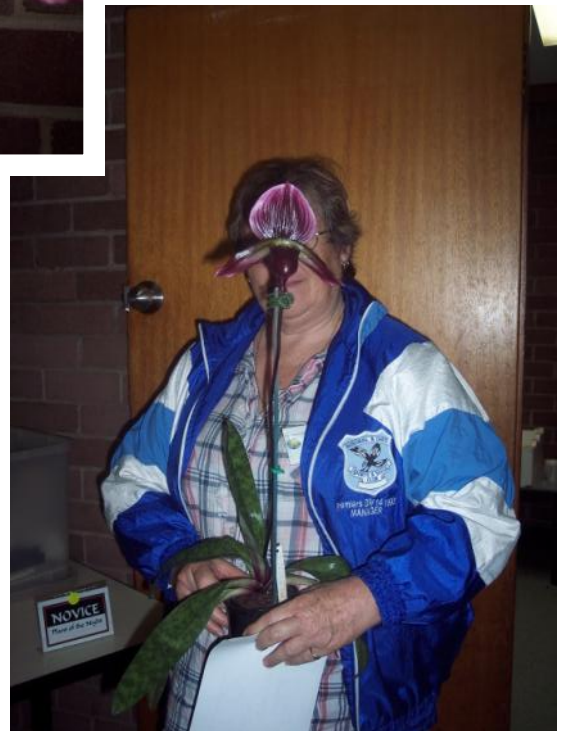

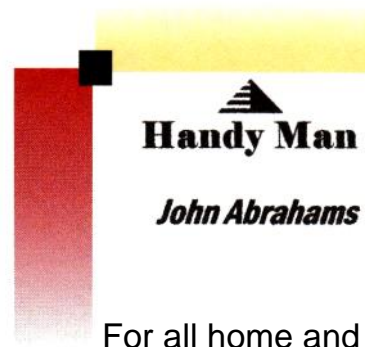
