## CONDITIONS OF ENTRY:

1. Entries are free and all competitive sections are open only to the financial members of the Fairfield District Orchid Society Inc.
2. Fairfield District Orchid Society Inc will take all reasonable care of the exhibits and sales plants but shall not be responsible for any loss or damage to such plants and the exhibitor shall have no claim against the Society, members or sponsors.
3. Set up Schedule, Tuesday 2 July
  - 4.30 pm to 5.00 pm – meet at Hall to load trestles and Show materials.
  - 5.30 pm to 6.30 pm – set up and dress benches at the Fairfield Forum
  - 6.30 pm to 7.30 pm – book in exhibits
  - 7.30 pm – bench sale plants

NO EXHIBITS WILL BE ACCEPTED AFTER 7.30 pm. on Tuesday 2 July.  
Judging will commence at 9.00 am on Wednesday 3 July

4. Judging will be in accordance with the standard of the Orchid Society of N.S.W. (OSNSW) and the judges' decision will be final. If, in the opinion of the judges, no exhibit in any class warrants a prize, no prize will be awarded.
5. Each plant must be CLEARLY and CORRECTLY labeled, CLEAN and SHOWING NO SIGN OF DISEASE. Exhibits showing such signs, especially colour breakdown in leaves will be rejected from the show bench. Exhibitor's name must NOT be shown.
6. PLANTS COMPETING FOR PRIZES SHALL HAVE BEEN OWNED AND IN THE POSSESSION OF THE EXHIBITOR FOR THE PRECEDING SIX (6) MONTHS.
7. DEFINITION OF A NOVICE: The winning of the aggregate point score in three (3) genera in a year or the winning of a major championship in this or any other Society affiliated with OSNSW results in a Novice member being promoted to OPEN in all genera at the end of that calendar year. Each member who has exhibited as a novice for four (4) years in this or any other Society affiliated with OSNSW is automatically promoted to OPEN at the end of that period. A novice may voluntarily exhibit in an OPEN class or classes but may not later those classes in NOVICE. Any member, who is in Open in one or more affiliated Societies, is deemed to be in Open Class in all affiliated Societies.

8. The Society's Management Committee reserves the right to reject any plant without giving reasons for such rejection. ONLY THE SHOW MARSHAL OR HIS ASSISTANTS SHALL BENCH PLANTS.

9. All Measurements where applicable shall be overall width of flowers.

10. **Pull down Schedule, Saturday, 6 July**

- 2:30pm-3.00 pm – box up members' remaining sale plants.
- 2:30pm-3.00 pm – members of the public to pick up plants purchased from exhibition benches.
- 3.00 pm-3:30 pm – members to remove exhibition plants from show benches.
- 4 pm – pull down benches, one at a time, commencing with those that are furthest from the sale table. The sales table to be the last one dismantled.

*If plants cannot be collected at this time, please arrange for someone else to collect them on your behalf*

11. Prizes will be handed out at the Society's July/August meeting.

12. Help is also required to dismantle the Show and return tables and other items to the Hall at Villawood. Please do not leave all the work to the same willing few. As they say, many hands make light work and after all the show is for all members. Any help you give will be greatly appreciated by your Committee and fellow members.

**Please note:** That anybody watering plants after they have been benched on the Show or Sale tables will have all plants removed from the show entirely. Water protruding from pots on arrival & through the show will not be accepted.
